TO THE VOTERS OF KANKAKEE COUNTY:

PUBLIC SAFETY SALES TAX

To pay for Public Safety purposes, shall Kankakee County be authorized to impose an increase on its share of local sales taxes by .25% for a period not to exceed four (4) years?

“This would mean that a consumer would pay an additional 25 cents in sales tax for every \$100 dollars of tangible personal property bought at retail. If imposed, the additional tax would cease being collected at the end of 4 years, if not terminated earlier by a vote of the county board.”

Need to register to vote or update your registration after moving or changing your name?

Grace Period Registration is available now through Election Day, at the Kankakee County Clerk's office.

You will be required to vote at the time you update your registration.

To register to vote, you must be:

1. A U.S. Citizen.
2. At least 18 years of age by Election Day.
3. A resident of your precinct at least 30 days prior to election day.

In order to register, you must provide two forms of identification, one of which must include your current address. Acceptable forms of identification include:

- Illinois driver's license/ID Card
- Social Security card
- Valid U.S. Passport
- Employee or student ID
- Birth certificate
- Public Aid ID Card
- Credit Card
- Utility bill in applicant's name
- Lease or rental contract



Additionally, you may register to vote or update your registration and vote on Election Day at the County Clerk's office or at your correct polling place.
