**Grace period registration and voting is also available. Grace period registration and voting is for persons who failed to register or update their address prior to the March 10th close of registration. Persons wishing to register to vote must be 18 years old by Election Day, present two forms of identification one of which must have their current address. Individuals who register or update their address through grace period registration must vote at that time.**
